A study of the American Psychological Association says there is no scientific evidence that parents' sexual orientation can influence or decide the ability of being good fathers or mothers. While in Italy the Catholic Church has always opposed gays and lesbians' rights, especially the one to have children through artificial insemination and the one to adopt a child, in a country like Israel –strongly influenced by religion, too – it is not rare to see two men or two women walking embraced while pushing a stroller.
